THBS In-House Tournament!

Our January THBS Inhouse tournament dates are scheduled for January 14th, 15th and 17th.

Cost to enter is \$10.00 per person and for each 5 entries received, we pay out 1 winner. The more entries received, the more winners we get. We always like to ensure we

have a minimum of 15 entries which permits us to pay out the top three positions.

For the THBS In-House, the total of your three bowled games along with your handicap multiplied by 3 is used to determine your total score. Nora will tabulate all entries received and the winners will be paid out the following bowling session!

The High Bowling Score Game

Our January THBS Game dates are January 28th, 29th and 31st.

Cost to enter is \$10.00 per person and we will pay out the top three scores. The more entries received, the higher the pay outs for the Top Three Bowlers will be.

We would like to have a minimum of 10 to 15 bowlers per session.

For the THBS Game, your best game out of the three games bowled will be combined with your handicap to give you a total, if your overall total gets you in the top three, we will pay you out the following week upon verification from Nora.

I Do Declare!!

To declare a score, prior to the start of the bowling session, see Nora to purchase a "Declared Score"

The cost to declare a game is \$15, which is the same as the weekly lane fees.

You can also declare more than once, if you pay the extra fees.

If you do not use your de-

clared score, we will refund it at the end of the season. Only 1 refund per session is permitted.

It happens every year, either an emergency occurs or the weather is bad and you are unable to make it to the lanes.

Bowling will never be cancelled as we need to maintain our schedule. If you are absent and there are no spares, it will **still cost** you \$15 for the missed session and your team will be forced to use a dummy score.

Be a team player and keep a declared score in the bank!

"Don't leave your team with a Dummy Score"

50/50 Draw, Mystery Score & Strike It Rich



Winner! Winner! Chicken Dinner!

50/50 Strike Pot cost \$2 for a small strip and \$5.00 for a large strip. If your ticket is drawn and you bowl a strike, you win 50% of the pot. If you fail to get your strike, you can spare for \$20, if you miss the spare, you win \$15. This only applies to the first draw in the event of multiple draws.

Mystery Score cost is \$2.

Scores are pulled randomly at intermission. If the score of your first game matches the score that is selected, you win 50% of the funds collected unless there are multiple winners. All scores from 0 to 300 are included.

Proceeds from the 50/50 draw and the Mystery Score sales help our league raise the needed funds for our

year end Banquet and awards. The more money that is raised during the year, the easier it is for us to subsidize the cost of your banquet ticket and to maintain our prize fund structure.

We've had a few of our newer bowlers this year win some pretty impressive Strike Pots and would love to see this trend continue! All you need is one ticket and a little bit of luck or a strike and TA-DA!

Even if you don't get the strike, you still have the chance of either winning \$20 or \$15.

The cost for our Strike It Rich is only \$1.00 The Pot grows weekly as each session participates! The only thing you need to do is bowl the required strikes, let Nora know and upon verification, it's all yours! See the lane flyers for more information.
