Strike It Rich!

We are thieves! This is popular with our summer league, so we are implementing our own version for our Fall / Winter Sessions.

For the cost of \$1, if you bowl 7 strikes in the designated frames, you will win 50% of the funds collected.

The pot will continue to grow with each and every session bowled until we have a winner(s)! In the event of multiple wins, the funds will be split equally.

If you paid your entry and you have bowled the 7 strikes in the designated

frames, advise Nora for validation. The pay out of the winnings will occur the next session and we start a new pot.

If there are no winners for the entire season, the funds will get reclassified as league revenue.

Tickets are drawn randomly. If your ticket is drawn, you have the chance to bowl a strike. If you succeed, you get 50% of the pot. If you fail, you can try for a spare for \$20. If you miss

that, we will give you \$16.

Mystery Score cost \$2 to enter. The VP will draw bowling scores from a bag and announce them. All possible scores have been included in the bag, 84 and below inclusively, 85 to 250 individually and 251 and above inclusively.

The winner is determined if the score announced matches the score of your first game. 50% of the funds collected are paid out to the winner(s)

We have 2 very simple ways for you to ensure you never leave your team desperately seeking spares!

A Declared Score:

Declared Scores are great when you know you will be away.

Prior to going away, you will want to declare some scores to ensure that your team is covered for the duration of your absence.

To do this, simply see Nora prior to the start of bowling and advise her that you would like to declare your score for one, two, etc., game(s). Cost is \$16 per declared score, same as regular bowling.

You do not need to declare all the scores at once, you can do this over a period of time prior to you being away.

Nora will provide you with the required amount of score sheets to record your bowling scores.

Our bowling season will end in April and You bowl your regular game and upwere bowled, 1st in, 1st out.

> Every year, we highly recommend that every bowler have at least one (1) declared score in the bank in case of an emergency or very bad weather. This ensures that you are covered and will not need to pay \$16 for being absent. You'd be amazed at how many bowlers do not do this and need to pay \$16 because something unexpected came up!

> If you do not use the declared score, it will be refunded at the end of the season (Max 1 refund / session). There is a maximum number of declared scores that you can complete in a season per session. (30% of the regular games)

A Bowl Off:

Bowl offs are used when you do not have a declared score in the bank and something has come up prior to your regular bowling session but you are still able to make it to the lanes before hand.

Contact Thorncliffe at 416-421-2211 to confirm operating hours and lane availability.

When you show up at the lanes; let the counter staff know that you are completing a bowl-off for THBS. Thorncliffe will charge you lane fees, give you a score sheet and assign you to a lane to complete your three games.

Register your scores as you complete your games and have them printed at the end of the three games by the counter staff. Place these in the designated THBS Declared Score Box and the scores will be used to cover your immediate absence.

Upon your return, you will need to pay a top up fee to bring the fees charged by Thorncliffe in line with the leagues regular lane fees.

Lastly, if none of the above options work, ensure you get a spare bowler to cover you. Alert your Team Captain and / or your VP and / or use Facebook to try and solidify obtaining a spare for your team. If a spare is available, they will cover your absence, if no one is available, you will be recorded as absent, your team will get a dummy score and you will need to pay \$16 for being absent along with your regular lane fees.
